
# IRON COUNTY OUTPOST CAMP EVALUATION

#### OVERALL EXPERIENCE

- 15 people responded to the survey.
- 80% of participants (12 people) rated their overall experience as Excellent.
- **20%** of participants (3 people) rated their overall experience as **Good**.
- The average rating was 4.80 out of 5, with 5 being the highest rating.

### DISCOVERIES & CHALLENGES

- New Interests & Skills: When asked about discovering new outdoor interests or skills, 6 people said "a lot" and 4 people said "a great deal".
- Most Impactful Moments: Participants most often mentioned the electric triangle, cooking, campfires, and fishing as the most impactful parts of their experience.
  - o One participant said they "overcame my fear of worms".
  - o Several campers specifically mentioned learning how to cook their own food.
- Overcoming Challenges: The most frequently mentioned challenge that campers overcame was the electric triangle.
  - One camper said they felt "challenged" by it, while another said overcoming it made them feel "good".
  - Campers also mentioned challenges like setting up tents and canoeing.

## TEAMWORK & LEADERSHIP

- **Effective Teamwork:** The **electric triangle** was overwhelmingly cited as the time when groups worked together most effectively.
- Felt Important: 6 people felt their contributions were "a lot" important to the group's success, and 3 people felt they were "a great deal" important.
- Gained New Skills:
  - 7 people said they had "a lot" of opportunities to help other group members, and 7 said "a great deal".
  - 6 people learned "a lot" of new ways to communicate effectively with their peers, and 3 learned "a great deal".
  - 7 people said they learned "a lot" about how to help their group solve problems, and 6 people said they learned "a great deal".

#### SUGGESTIONS FOR IMPROVEMENT

- More Snacks: The most common suggestion for improvement was to have more snacks or specific food items, such as peaches, apples, and drinks.
- Worms: Two people requested "more worms".
- The Electric Triangle: One person suggested removing the electric triangle, while multiple people said "nothing" needed to be changed, and that the camp was "perfect".
